Subject: REPORT ON THE 11th NEW MOTOR VEHICLE BOARD INDUSTRY ROUNDTABLE

On April 10, 2014, the New Motor Vehicle Board (“Board”) held its 11th Industry Roundtable. Over 50 people attended the event, in addition to several Board members and staff. The attendees represented industry associations, dealers, manufacturers, private sector vendors and the government. Surveys were provided to the attendees in order to solicit feedback on the topics presented.

Positive feedback was received both on the surveys and also by Board staff members in attendance. Many attendees commented that they found the discussion on odometer fraud very interesting and enlightening.

The presentations on Autonomous Vehicles (“AVs”) were well received and several attendees would like to hear updates on the progression of AVs at future roundtables

One attendee would also like as a future topic a presentation from Department of Motor Vehicles staff on how processing of dealership documents and appointments differs from office to office.

Many attendees commented that they appreciated that the materials and PowerPoint presentation were available on the Board’s website so that they could be shared with colleagues who were unable to attend.
