

NEW MOTOR VEHICLE BOARD

Sections Affected in Title 13: 550.10, 551,551.1, 551.6, 553.40, 583, and 598

Justification for Changes without Regulatory Effect:

The New Motor Vehicle Board is in the process of reviewing all of its regulations for consistency and accuracy. During that review it was noted that there were some inaccurate references to “subchapter”; the proper reference is “chapter”. Furthermore, there are inaccurate references to Vehicle Code section 11723 in the Reference and one regulation does not have any Authority or Reference.

Sections 550.10, 553.40, and 598 contain references to “subchapter” so they are being amended to reflect “chapter”.

The reference to the Government Code in Section 551 is missing “Part 1”. It should read: “Chapter 5, Part 1, Division 3, Title 2 of the Government Code (commencing with Section 11500 thereof).” Additionally, since there is no Authority or Reference, it is being amended to reflect: “Note: Authority cited: Section 3050(a), Vehicle Code. Reference: Sections 1, et seq., and 3000, et seq., Vehicle Code; Section 11500, et seq., Government Code”.

The Reference in Sections 551.1 and 551.6 is being amended to reflect the proper code references and delete an inaccurate reference to Vehicle Code section 11713.

Since filing fees are paid by the party filing a petition, appeal, or protest, and the party responding to it, the Reference in Section 553.40 is being amended to reflect all of the Vehicle Code sections pertaining to petitions, appeals, and protests.

The Reference in Section 583 is being updated to reflect Section 3050 of the Vehicle Code without reference to any subdivisions.

The changes are needed to update and clarify the Board’s regulations. The changes qualify as a Title, 1, CCR, section 100 change because they do “...not materially alter any requirement, right, responsibility, condition, prescription or other regulatory element of any California Code of Regulations provision.”
