20 Code section 3062 and alleges as follows:

WHEREFORE, Protestant prays as follows:

1. That the Board (or its authorized representative) immediately advise Respondent that a protest has been filed;

2. That a hearing of the Protest is required pursuant to Vehicle Code section 3066; and,

3. That, pursuant to Vehicle Code sections 3062 and 3063, Respondent may not approve the off-site sale if the Board determines that there is good cause for not permitting it.
